

- To date, Envest has:
  - ✓ **Displaced** ~ 3,000,000 tonnes of CO₂ emissions
  - ✓ Diverted nearly 500,000 tonnes of organic waste from landfills
  - ✓ Produced over 500,000 tonnes of organic fertilizer






#### WASTE FREE ONTARIO ACT, 2016, S.O. 2016, c.12 – Bill 151

- Waste Free Ontario Act, 2016, S.O. 2016, c.12 Bill 151:
  - Provincial legislation enacted in 2016, comprising the Resource Recovery and Circular Economy Act and the Waste Diversion Transition Act.
  - Legislative and policy framework driving demand in Ontario's SSO Market
  - Legally obligates municipalities, and other entities, to act in accordance with resource recovery and waste reduction Policy Statements
  - Outlines waste reduction and waste diversion targets
- Waste reduction and resource recovery targets:
  - Southern Ontario Municipalities: 70% waste reduction and resource recovery of organic waste by 2025
  - Northern Ontario Municipalities: 50% waste reduction and resource recovery 1
     of organic waste by 2025
- Waste diversion from landfill targets:
  - 2020 30%
  - 2030 50%
  - 2050 80%
- Results:
  - In 2022, Ontario diverted 25% of its waste, reaching 83% of the 2020 target




## 4. Southgate Renewables

### **SOUTHGATE RENEWABLES**



- > 100 Eco Parkway, Dundalk, ON
  - 10-acre site
  - 100 km from Disco facility
- Good distance from major feedstock sources:
  - Toronto
  - Halton
  - Peel Region
  - Durham Region
  - York Region



- Fully permitted: Anaerobic digestor project to process 73,000 tonnes per year of incoming organic residuals to produce 200,000 GJ per year of RNG under ECA permit #1984-BD9NBD
- **Interconnection**: RNG will be injected into the adjacent Enbridge pipeline (biogas services agreement signed in 2021)
- Location: Good proximity to GTA, less than 2 hours from Toronto in Dundalk's Industrial Park
  - Surrounded by similar facilities such as Walker (composting); Tomlinson (biosolids) & municipal WWTP
- Public support: Excellent local political and planning support
  - Open House on February 24, 2023 with Member of Provincial Parliament attending
- **Experience**: Similar in size to our Seacliff digestor, offering many opportunities in lessons-learned, planning, engineering, implementation, operations, staffing, etc.
- Fertilizer: Liquids effluent is organic fertilizer, displacing fossil nitrogen fertilizers, provided to local farmers
  - Pioneered by Seacliff Energy in Ontario



- ✓ Second 5-acre parcel acquired in 2022
- ✓ Total area = 10 acres







- Envest–MCBLP–MSIFN to own Southgate Renewables
  - Envest Corp.
  - Mississaugas of the Credit Business LP (MCBLP)
  - Mississaugas of Scugog Island First Nation (MSIFN)
- Envest–MCBLP–MSIFN will build, own, operate, and finance the Southgate Renewables bioenergy facility to recycle organics and produce renewable natural gas ("RNG").
- Indigenous / private sector partnership self-funded model passes synergies & core competencies of the partners through as value creation
- Indigenous / private partnership model has been successfully established through Envest projects such as the \$150M Voisey's Bay Wind project by Innu-Inuit Envest LP in Labrador
