SUPPORTVE

Affordable: Supportive housing provides affordable living options, ensuring that residents can maintain their housing stability through rent subsidies and income-based payments. **Support services:** It offers a range of essential services, including mental health counseling, substance abuse treatment, employment assistance, and case management, designed to address individual needs.

Community integration: fostering social inclusion and interaction, reducing stigma, and creating a sense of belonging for residents.

An innovative approach to addressing homelessness and improving the well-being of vulnerable individuals. It combines affordable housing with essential support services for people who are experiencing homelessness, struggling with mental health issues, or facing other challenges.

Supportive housing is not just a place to live; it's a holistic solution that helps people regain their independence and rebuild their lives

The building opened in November 2023



July 1, 2024, the first graduate from the program moved into Grey County housing



At this time, the program is for residents of Grey County only
